## AMJournal Author Terms and Conditions

Failure to adhere to the Amsterdam Museum Journal author terms and conditions will result in the exclusion from publication (without exceptions).

**All authors must agree to, and adhere to, the following author terms and conditions:**

1. Authors adhere to the specified AMJournal Author Guidelines (see the website);
2. Authors adhere to the AMJournal deadlines. Authors understand that deviating from the prescribed deadlines may result in exclusion from publication;
3. The Amsterdam Museum must be notified as soon as possible if authors are unable to meet the deadlines;
4. Authors will provide all documents in a neat and timely manner;
5. Authors only submit entirely original work. Plagiarism in any form will result in exclusion from publication;
6. Authors are responsible for ensuring that all visual images they use are of their own making or copyright-free. If images turn out to be licensed, the contribution will be excluded from AMJournal.
7. Authors do not minimize the contribution of any (junior) researchers that aided in the study they are seeking to publish with AMJournal. Failure to do so, counts as plagiarism and will result in exclusion from publication;
8. Only those who made significant contributions to the text or study itself may be listed as authors of the text. This includes those who were involved in research design, data collection, dataprocessing, data analysis or evaluation, and content revision of the tekst;
9. All those who provided technical or critical support, as well as those who aided in the copy editing of the text should be acknowledged in the text;
10. Authors disclose all sources of financial support;

11. Authors get written permission for any information obtained privately from third parties.
12. Authors will only publish research that involves human or animal participants if it has been lawfully and ethically obtained (according to Dutch Law). In all cases, the privacy of research participants must be protected by the authors. For all data obtained from human participants, authors have obtained a signed informed consent form;
13. Authors adhere to the high standard of textual quality AMJournal outlines in its mission statement;
14. Essays and papers must be submitted as Microsoft Word documents via email (journal@amsterdammuseum.nl);
15. Authors declare that the essay or papers for the Amsterdam Museum Journal will not and have not been published elsewhere (this goes for papers currently under consideration elsewhere as well);
16. There is no conflict of interest for the author or the Amsterdam Museum Journal;
17. Authors are responsible for all copyediting in C1-C2 English. Failure to submit a sufficiently copy-edited final text will result in exclusion from publication;
18. Authors are aware that the Amsterdam Museum Journal is an online open access journal;
19. Authors are aware that they will be subjected to a peer review process and will fully comply. Failure to comply will result in exclusion from publication;

20. Authors provide their revised versions according to the feedback in the peer reviews and provide the peer reviewers with an explanation on the changes in a Word Document called 'Letter to the reviewers';
21. Authors are aware that when major revisions are advised, failure to include these changes may result in exclusion from publication (even in an advance stage of the process);
22. Authors will notify AMJournal immediately if any significant errors or inaccuracies are found after publication;
23. Authors can write things in their own voice and be critical. Nevertheless, any discriminatory or scientifically unsupported content will not be considered for publication.
